

Bioeconomy: bioenergy leads the way




- 150 community heat projects in 2014 using only biomass (from 5 projects in 2000)
- Pulp and paper the largest industrial source of cogeneration
- 77 Operating biogas installations in 2013 (from 43 operations in 2012)
- Renewable fuel consumption doubled from 2010-2014

Regulations and Standards


Standards, codes, regulations (e.g. building codes, criteria and indicators)




